The Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 (SI 2015 No.234) and  
The Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014

1. **Date of Announcement** – 1 June 2017

2. **Section 26 and 27 of the Local Audit Accountability Act 2014 provide for:**

**Inspection:** Any persons interested may inspect and make copies of the Annual Return and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts etc. relating to them. For the year ending 31 March 2017 these documents will be available during the period specified under paragraph 4 below on reasonable notice on application to the Responsible Finance Officer.

**Questions and objections to the external auditor:** Local Government electors and their representatives have rights to:

- Question the auditor about the accounts; and
- Object to the accounts or any item in them. Written notice of an objection must be given to the external auditor and a copy sent to the authority. Objections must concern a matter of which the external auditor could make a public interest report or apply for a declaration that an item of account is unlawful.
